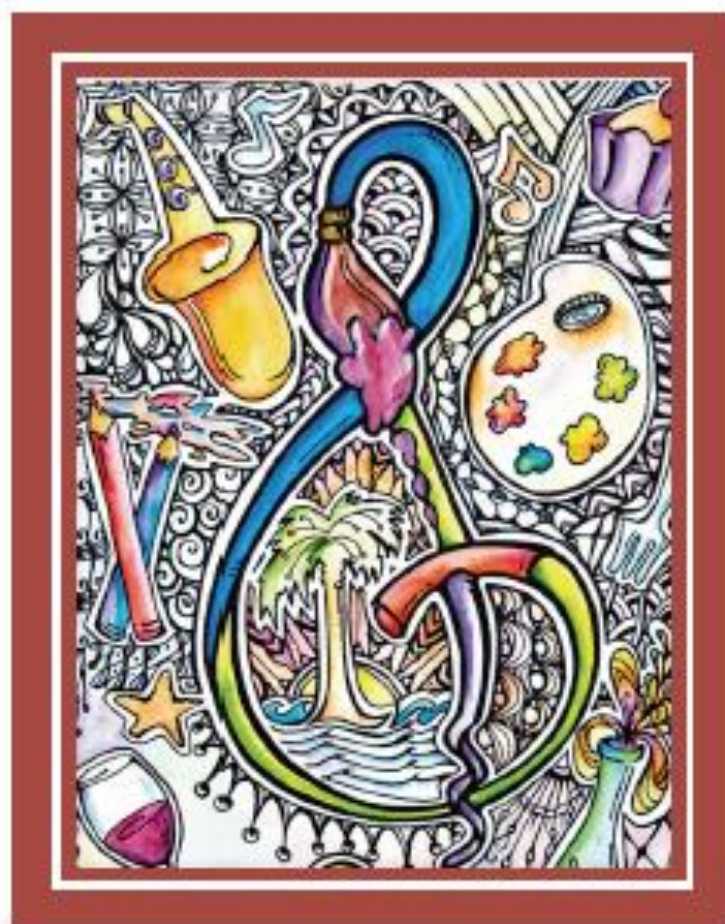

We will have lots of fabrics and materials to decorate your square but please feel free to bring some of your own materials...and Men don't be afraid we really need you to join in and help. We have expert help and instruction.

The Brief if you wish to bring a finished piece to add – all squares must be cut to 25cm square, the work area should be no more than a 20cm square (2.5cm added for seam and cutting allowance) Our theme is 'LIFE IN THE COTTAGES'

We will leave it up to you how you want to express this!

Sewing, applique, embroidery its up to you how you decorate.

If you wish to make this in advance and want a square please collect these from 47 Albert road.

Saturday 20th of September at 12pm until Sunday 21st of September to 4pm

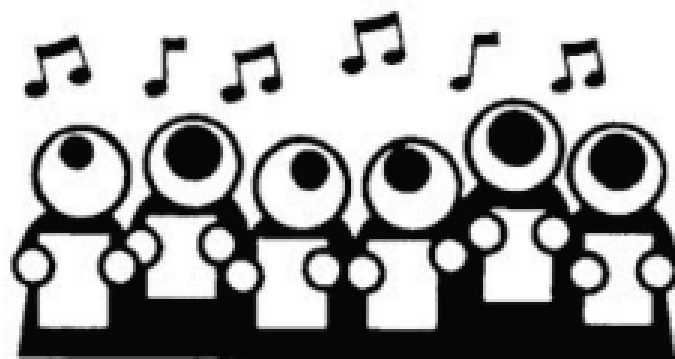
The theme is based on 'Life in the Cottages'
